REQUIREMENTS:

Ability to travel to World Cup and preparatory events is required.

Valid state driver's license is required.

Those with Small Unmanned Aircraft Systems (SUAS) (aka. Drone) and/or Counter Unmanned Aircraft System Programs. experience are preferred.

INTRODUCTION:

This position is located in the Department of Homeland Security (DHS), U.S. Customs and Border Protection (CBP), U.S. Border Patrol (USBP), and serves as an Engineering Equipment Operator in the Law Enforcement Operations Directorate (LEOD), Unmanned Technology Operations Center (UTOC). The incumbent(s) will work alongside and support the CBP' Counter Unmanned Aircraft System Program in support of World Cup 2026 preparations.

MAJOR DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES

In this position you will serve as Engineering Equipment Operator, focused on special support for the upcoming World Cup 2026 protection efforts. Typical work assignments include:

Supporting counter unmanned aircraft systems (C-UAS) teams' efforts. The operator follows oral and written instructions concerning the location of the job and work to be done.

Learning required steps and functions to support the team during and leading up to special security events, including the World Cup 2026. Lead and teach other team members during preparation, planning, transport, loading/unloading, set-up and tear down of sensitive C-UAS equipment and communications related equipment for World Cup and World Cup preparations.

Maintaining incident logs from special events for the National C-UAS Director.

Performing reporting and scribe duties as needed both pre-planning, during, and post event.

Maintaining and update highlights related to planning and events to be used by the C-UAS team for briefing reference materials.

Duties involve the use of hand and motor-powered tools and equipment such as electric powered drills and drivers, ladders, telecommunications hardware, pliers, etc.

Supporting daily integration of activities related to SUAS/CUAS Operations, Intelligence, Logistics, Policy, Training, and Procurement functions.

Ensuring the safety of Border Patrol Agents and their law enforcement partners by facilitating concise and timely communication and information dissemination.
