


Fort Benning Risk Reduction Targets Prevention



The Risk Reduction Program (RRP) is a Commander's tool designed to identify and decrease Soldiers high-risk behaviors (i.e. Substance Abuse, Suicide, Spousal/Child Abuse, and AWOL). The program focuses on effective use of installation resources and coordinated efforts between Commanders and installation agencies to implement effective interventions.

RISK FACTORS AND DEFINITIONS

RISK FACTORS	DEFINITION
1. Deaths	The number of deaths among members of this reporting unit. These include all deaths, for example, natural and accidental deaths, and suicides.
2. Accidents	The number of accidents involving \$2,000 or more damage to government property assigned to this reporting unit.
3. Injuries	The number of injuries among members of this reporting unit that require medical attention and result in one or more duty days lost.
4. Sexually Transmitted Diseases (STDs)	The number of new cases of STDs among members of this reporting unit (whether they remain deployable or become non-deployable). These include all forms of STDs, for example, gonorrhea, venereal warts, and HIV.
5. Suicide Gestures & Attempts	The number of suicide gestures and suicide attempts by members of this reporting unit.
6. AWOLs	The number of AWOL charges brought against members of this reporting unit.
7. Drug Offenses	The number of drug offenses charged to members of this reporting unit. These include, for example, possession and sale (but not use) of a controlled substance.
8. Alcohol Offenses	The number of alcohol-related offenses charged to members of this reporting unit. These include, e.g., DWI/DUI, public intoxication, drunk and disorderly, alcohol-related reckless driving, possession by a minor, and consumption by a minor.
9. Traffic Violations	The number of moving traffic violations charged to members of this reporting unit. These include, for example, speeding, failure to obey a traffic device, accidents, and non-alcohol-related reckless driving.
10. Crimes Against Persons	The number of crimes against persons charged to members of this reporting unit. These include, for example, simple assault, aggravated assault, murder, robbery, concealed weapons, kidnapping, harassment and threats, sodomy, rape, indecent assault, adultery, and forgery. (Do not include any of the Drug Offenses or Alcohol Offenses in this risk factor.)
11. Crimes Against Property	The number of crimes against property charged to members of this reporting unit. These include, for example, house breaking/burglary, auto theft, arson, theft of government property, theft of private property, damage to property, and vandalism.
12. Spouse Abuse	The number of substantiated cases of spouse abuse where the perpetrator is a member of this reporting unit.
13. Child Abuse	The number of substantiated cases of child abuse where the perpetrator is a member of this reporting unit.
14. Financial Problems	The number of cases of financial problems among members of this reporting unit. These include, for example, AER loans & grants, debt liquidation, and financial mismanagement.

RISK FACTORS AND DEFINITIONS

RISK FACTORS	DEFINITION
15. UA Samples Shipped	The number of urinalysis samples from this reporting unit that were shipped for testing.
16. Positive UAs	The number of confirmed positive urinalysis test results among members of this reporting unit.

RISK FACTORS	DEFINITION
17. Warning Letters	The number of letters to members of this reporting unit warning that, if inappropriate behavior continues, the consequence will be a loss of on-post housing.
18. Eviction Notices	The number of notices indicating that members of this reporting unit have been evicted from on-post housing.
19. Chapter Eliminations	The number of chapter eliminations in this reporting unit that are based on Chapters 5, 9, 10, 13, or 14.
20. Courts Martial	The number of courts martial in this reporting unit.
21. Disciplinary Actions	The number of administrative disciplinary actions (non-judicial) in this reporting unit.

READING THE SHOT GROUP/BULLSEYE CHART

The Shot Group report provides a graphical method for users to see how their unit (Installation, DCG, Unit, etc.) compares with the Army for each risk factor within a given reporting period.

In appearance, the graphic looks similar to a standard target used in a firing range.

The bullet holes are plotted on the Shot Group Report according to the following scheme:

<u>COLOR</u>	<u>BAND</u>
Red	Greater than 2X Army Rate
Yellow	Greater than Army Rate but less than 2X
White	Army Rate
Green	US Army RRP Rate
Black	Less than Army rate






