The United States Army Infantry Center, Directorate of Public Works, Environmental Management Division, Fort Benning, Georgia, hereby announces the completion and public availability of the Annual Mitigation Monitoring Report for the Digital Multi-Purpose Range Complex (DMPRC). The status of the environmental mitigation and monitoring for the DMPRC, as detailed in the Final Environmental Impact Statement (EIS) and Record of Decision (R.O.D.), were prepared pursuant to the National Environmental Policy Act of 1969, the Council on Environmental Quality regulations 40CFR 1500, and Army regulation 200-2.

As with the previous Annual Reports, this report summarizes the progress of the required environmental mitigation and monitoring and notes any deficiencies and corrective action. During project design changes, efforts were made to avoid significant impacts to the environment by avoidance and placement of targets and trails in areas that would minimize the environmental impacts of the design change. This Annual Report summarizes these design modifications, as well as providing an analysis of any changes in associated environmental impacts, mitigation, or monitoring.

The Annual Report is also being used to document the evaluation of design changes and the resulting determination that supplemental NEPA documentation is not required. While multiple design changes have been made, adverse environmental impacts are not expected to be significant. The time frame covered by this Annual Report is January 01, 2007 through December 31, 2007.
