



CSM ANGULO, MARTIN

CSM Angulo enlisted in the Army in June 1994 as an Infantryman and was assigned to the 1<sup>st</sup> Battalion, 14<sup>th</sup> Infantry Regiment, 25<sup>th</sup> Infantry Division at Schofield Barracks, Hawaii where he served as a Rifleman and M60 Gunner. CSM Angulo's other assignments include 1<sup>st</sup> Battalion, 14<sup>th</sup> Infantry Regiment as a Scout Assistant Team Leader and Team Leader. He served in Alpha Company 1<sup>st</sup> Battalion, 24<sup>th</sup> Infantry, 1<sup>st</sup> Brigade, 25<sup>th</sup> Infantry Division, Fort Lewis Washington as a Team Leader and Squad Leader. He was assigned to Echo Company 102<sup>nd</sup> MI, Long Range Surveillance Detachment, 2<sup>nd</sup> Infantry Division at Camp Hovey, Korea as an Assistant Team Leader and Team Leader.

CSM Angulo's next assignment brought him back to 1<sup>st</sup> Battalion, 14<sup>th</sup> Infantry Regiment where he served as a Platoon Sergeant and Battalion S-2 NCOIC, First Sergeant for Bravo Company 1<sup>st</sup> Battalion, 14<sup>th</sup> Infantry Regiment and First Sergeant for Headquarters and Headquarters Company 1<sup>st</sup> Battalion, 14<sup>th</sup> Infantry Regiment. CSM Angulo's follow on assignment was in Fort Benning Georgia as the Battalion Operations NCO for 2<sup>nd</sup> Battalion, 54<sup>th</sup> Infantry Regiment and First Sergeant for Delta Company 2<sup>nd</sup> Battalion, 54<sup>th</sup> Infantry Regiment, He was then selected to attend the United States Army Sergeants Major Course Class 62. Following graduation of USASMA Class 62, CSM Angulo was then and currently assigned the CSM for 2<sup>nd</sup> Battalion, 351<sup>st</sup> Infantry Regiment, 158<sup>th</sup> Brigade, Camp Shelby Mississippi.

CSM Angulo's training and combat deployments include; Multiple Rotations to YTC, NTC, PTA and Kangaroo 95', The Northern Warfare Center and Infantry Company Course, the Jungle Operations Training Course, Bosnia Herzegovina SFOR 11, Operation Iraqi Freedom 00-03, and Operation Iraqi Freedom 07-09. CSM Angulo also represented both 2<sup>nd</sup> and 25<sup>th</sup> Infantry Divisions in the Best Ranger Competition in 2001 and 2007 respectively.
