



Basic Airborne Course (BAC) Graduation



On 21 MAY 21, ARTB will conduct BAC class 21-21 graduation ceremony at Eubanks Field. Graduation will be open to invited guests; COVID mitigation will be enforced.

Graduation General Rules

- Guests must show proof of a negative COVID test within the last 72 hours or proof of vaccination.
- Face masks are required at all times during graduations, except when consuming food or drink.
- Families in spectator areas must socially distance.
- Guests will be limited to two (2) adults per graduate.
- Guests will only be allowed to interact with students after graduation and release, and with only those personnel departing the 507th for follow-on assignments. Guest will not be allowed to interact with students who will remain in a "holdover status."

Seating Plan

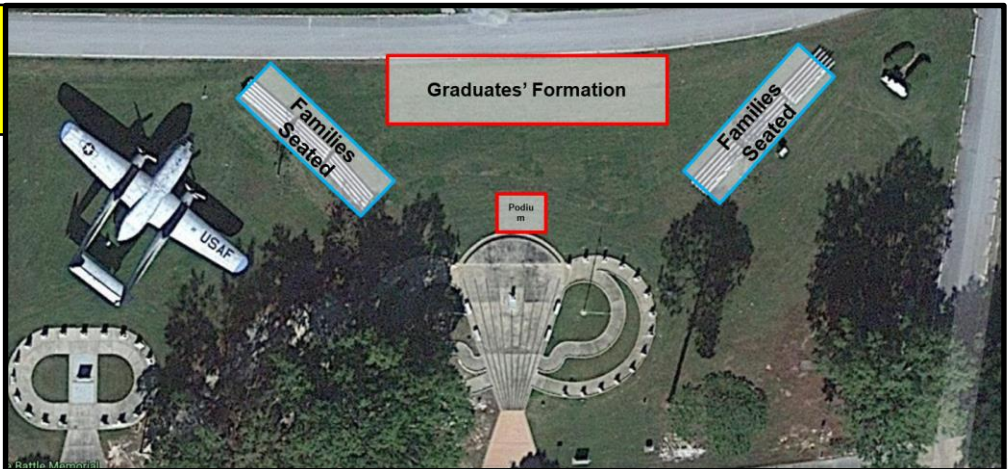
- Seats will be sectioned off for social distancing.
- Bleachers will be sectioned by Platoon to allow families better viewing of their graduate.
- 1-507th cadre will guide guests to their designated seating areas.
- Facemasks and hand sanitizer will be available.

Execution Concept

- Silver Wings will conduct Military Freefall into the graduation area.
- Graduates will march to the formation area.
- Remarks begin.
- Graduates will open ranks and receive airborne wings from Airborne Instructors.
- Graduates will close ranks followed by speaker closing remarks, then march off the field.
- Families will have time with the Soldiers once released from BAC.

COVID 19 Guidelines

- From HWY 185 South
- Head S toward Lindsey Creek PKWY
- Take ramp onto Custer Rd
- Turn left on Ft. Benning Rd
- Turn right onto 10th DIV Rd
- Turn left onto Anderson St
- Take 3rd exit at traffic circle onto Marchant St
- Turn right onto Riordan St
- Turn left at ABN HQ and destination will be on left
