

LAST DATE UPDATED:

1. TRAINING / REPORT LOCATION: All courses report to the Army Mountain Warfare School, 8 Mountain School Road, Ethan Allen Firing Range Jericho, Vermont 05465. GPS: N 44.4796 W 072.9508
2. IN PROCESSING / REPORT TIME: All courses in processing start at 1230. If you CANNOT REPORT by 1600, call and make arrangements. If you DO NOT make arrangements, you risk losing your reservation. A statement of non-availability will be provided if you arrive early or need to stay after the course due to travel arrangements.
3. REPORT / TRAINING UNIFORM: Report uniform is ACU, OCP (MULTICAM), APFT or civilian. Training will be conducted in ACU or OCP.
4. IN PROCESSING PAPERWORK:
You are given 72 hours from the report date to produce incomplete documentation.
You are responsible for ensuring you meet all course prerequisites.
You are responsible to meet additional standards outlined in AR 40 501, DA PAM 611-21 and AR 600-9.
Bring the following paperwork:
 - (1) copy of orders OR DA Form 1610
 - (1) TRADOC Unit Pre-Execution Checklist 350-18-2-R-E dated JUL 2009
 - Advance Military Mountaineer Courses only: (1) copy of SQI "E" orders or BMMC Course Certificate.
5. HEIGHT / WEIGHT: If you do not meet HT/WT IAW AR 600-9 during in processing, Soldier will be released.
6. OUT-PROCESSING: Soldiers will out process prior to departure regardless of status.
7. GRADUATION: Graduation certificate, orders and DA Form 1059 is issued upon graduation.
8. RELEASES PRIOR TO COURSE COMPLETION: You may be released for any of the following:
 - Disciplinary reasons
 - Lack of motivation
 - Academic deficiency/lack of progress
 - Other valid reasons such as family illness or death
 - Missing a total of four hours of academic training
 - Major safety violation
9. ATTENDANCE: Soldiers who miss more than four (4) Program of Instruction (POI) required academic hours, continuous or cumulative, will be released from the course.
10. COMPLAINTS AND GRIEVANCES: The Chain of Command will be used for complaints and grievances.
11. BARRACKS:
 - **Barracks are not available before the report date or after graduation.** A statement of non-availability will be provided.
 - All Soldiers will stay in the provided government quarters at no cost during the course.
 - BASIC MILITARY MOUNTAINEER COURSE IS A LOCK DOWN COURSE and Soldiers CANNOT LEAVE POST.
 - ROUGH TERRAIN EVACUATION COURSE, MOUNTAIN PLANNERS COURSE AND MOUNTAIN RIFLEMAN'S COURSE are not locked down courses and Soldiers can leave post.
 - ADVANCED MILITARY MOUNTAINEER COURSES are not locked down courses and Soldiers can leave post.

- **ADVANCED MILITARY MOUNTAINEER COURSE (SUMMER ONLY):** There is a 3 day (2-night period when military quarters/rations are not available due to use of an off-post remote training area. A Statement of Non-Availability will be issued by the Army Mountain Warfare School for those dates. The AMWS will make reservations at the most cost-effective lodging in that area. The AMWS will provide transportation to that area. Soldiers should come with enough money and/or government credit card to pay for these reimbursable expenses.

12. **BARRACK NOTES: Fraternization is grounds for immediate dismissal.**

- Male barracks are OFF LIMITS to all female personnel, military or civilian.
- Female barracks are OFF LIMITS to male personnel, military or civilian.
- Cadre/Staff barracks are OFF LIMITS to all Soldiers.

13. **MEALS:** Meals are not available before or after scheduled course dates. Soldiers will use government rations during course of instruction.

14. **RENTAL VEHICLE:**

- **BMMC/ AMMC:** You do not need a rental vehicle during these courses.
- **ROUGH TERRAIN EVACUATION COURSE / MOUNTAIN PLANNERS COURSE / MOUNTAIN RIFLEMAN COURSE:** Are not a lock down course and a rental vehicle is necessary.
- **SHUTTLE SERVICE: AMWS provides shuttle service to and from the airport, bus and train stations for all courses of instruction.**

15. **TRAVEL: Schedule ALL RETURN FLIGHTS / TICKETS on or after 1600 hours on the day of graduation.**

AIRPORT: Fly to and from the BURLINGTON INTERNATIONAL AIRPORT (BTV) in Burlington, Vermont.

BUS: Located on Pine Street in Burlington, Vermont.

TRAIN: AMTRAK station located in Essex Junction, Vermont.

POV: Park in the designated student parking lot. POV's must meet registration and insurance requirements

16. **RELIGIOUS SERVICES:** Not available.

17. **SICK CALL:** Located on training schedules.

18. **SUPPLY:** Open IAW posted training schedule and will only issue supplemental items.

19. **PHYSICAL REQUIREMENTS / PROFILE / PREPARATION:** You are required to complete all physical fitness requirements to graduate. The inability to complete the movements to, from or during training will result in dismissal from the course. All courses are demanding and will require a concentrated effort. You should develop a physical training program that will prepare you to carry a 45 to 65 pound rucksack, five to eight kilometers daily in mountainous terrain under any environmental condition. All courses are oriented toward field training. Knowledge and on the ground experience in map reading and land navigation is essential.

20. **MAIL:** The Soldier mailing address is same as above.

21. **PERSONAL CONDUCT / APPEARANCE:** Soldiers will conduct themselves in a professional manner at all times and will conform to AR 670-1.

22. **DRUGS AND ALCOHOL IAW AR 600-85:** Soldiers will not possess or consume illegal drugs or alcohol. Soldiers violating this directive will immediately be removed from the course.

23. WEAPONS AND PROHIBITED ITEMS POLICY: All items prohibited by federal and state laws are prohibited. The Soldier possessing the contraband will be subject to appropriate legal action and/or UCMJ action. Personal firearms or weapons of any type are prohibited.
24. TRAINING SCHEDULE / INDIVIDUAL STUDENT EVALUATION PLAN: Posted on the student bulletin board.
25. SAFETY: Every Soldier is responsible for safety conscious habits and complying with safety policies
26. BARBERSHOP: No barbershop on post.
27. AAFES FACILITIES: No AAFES facilities or a commissary on post.
28. TELEPHONES: Government phones are for military use only. Cellphone reception is very unreliable.
29. COMPUTER/INTERNET ACCESS: AKO kiosks are set up for Soldier use. Paid internet available.
30. FITNESS CENTER: See training schedule for guidance upon arrival.
31. VENDING MACHINES: Located on the second floor of the building.
32. ATM: No ATM on post. Bring significant funds (\$50-\$100).
33. LAUNDRY: Self-serve free laundry available in building.
34. LINEN: (2) sheets, (1) pillow, (1) pillow case and (1) wool blanket are issued.
