- 2) Rank and unit patches will not be worn while in RSLC. Uniforms/Boots must be AR 670-1 or service regulation compliant
- 3) T-Shirts must be loose fitting cotton (NO TIGHT FITTING), UnderArmour or other athletic type T-shirts are not authorized

- 4) Students may bring similar items to the equipment listed <u>if their home station units authorizes its use</u>. e.g. Alice pack or Mystery Ranch Ruck sack vs the MOLLE ruck sack as long as it is IAW CAASOP & TC 3-21.220. Students are NOT allowed to bring their home station Night Vision Devices.
- 5) During the course, the wear of civilian clothing by students is only authorized after the completion of instruction for the day. During classroom instruction, uniforms must be in accordance with AR 670-1 or service equivalent. During field training, uniforms may adhere to home-station unit policy.
