

Ranger Students are expected to conduct a passing patrol, be in good standing with their peers, and have no major negative infractions in order to pass each phase.



Course Imposed Stress



- Prolonged low-intensity physical activity
 - 65-90lbs combat equipment
 - Tactical foot movements of 200+ mi
- Sleep deprivation
 - 0 to 5 hours of sleep a night
- Food consumption
 - 2200 calories a day (2x MREs/day)
- Environmental impacts
 - Darby – Mountains – Swamps
- Evaluated leadership positions
 - 2 patrols per phase
- Post phase peer evaluations
- Constant opposition force probing



Endstate: mentally and physically resilient; resourceful leaders




Graduation Rate Comparison FY22

Data includes all classes in FY22 (01-11)






