MEMORANDUM FOR: M-SLC & ALC Students

SUBJECT: Follow-on Ranger School

1. Upon completion of Maneuver Senior Leader Course or Advanced Leader Course, all graduates have the opportunity to attend Ranger School without regard to unit allocations. If you would like to take advantage of this opportunity or think you may be interested, you will need to bring with you the following documentation:

- ERB
- DD Form 93/SGLI
- Copy of Airborne Qualification (if Qualified)
- Memorandum for Separate Rations (signed by CMDR)
- Ranger Approved Physical Exam within 18 months of Course Start Date
- DD Form 2216E
- Copy of all required labs, radiology reports, and EKG as applicable
- MEDPROS printout that includes a routine immunization summary

2. The NCO Academy will assure you have the remaining documentation needed to attend Ranger School:

- Service School Worksheet
- PT Card
- DA 4187
- Ranger Task Proficiency Skills Worksheet w/attached certification memo.

3. During your NCOES instruction, NCOA Cadre will conduct separate PRT and land navigation training designed to increase your likelihood to successfully complete Ranger Assessment Phase (RAP) tasks. If your unit requires attendance at a Pre-Ranger Program (PRP), prior to attendance, we will attempt to schedule you here with the Warrior Training center (a recognized successful program). However, class graduation and Ranger school class start dates may prevent this.

3. If you decide to attend Ranger School after graduating from the NCO Academy, billeting will be provided until you attend the Ranger School. This will not cost you any additional TDY funds, and your unit will be responsible for amending TDY orders to reflect Ranger School.
