INFANTRY is available to subscribers at \$12.00 for one year and \$23.00 for two years. Foreign (non-APO) subscribers must add \$4.00 per subscription per year to cover the cost of surface mailing and handling. Foreign air mail rates will be furnished upon request. Single copies are \$2.50 each if sent to a U.S. address. Payment must be made in U.S. currency, by international money order, or by a check or draft drawn on a U.S. bank. For best service, payment should accompany each order, because we cannot start a subscription until we have received full payment for it. Checks, money orders, or drafts should be made payable to INFANTRY. One-year subscriptions are not refundable; two-year subscriptions are refundable, but service and handling charges will be deducted.
