The Warrior Training Center (WTC) Air Assault Course (AAC) is 12 days in duration. The AAC is conducted in 3 phases: Combat Assault Operations, Sling Load Operations and Rappelling. The AAC culminates with students conducting a 12-mile foot march to be completed within 3 hours or less with a complete packing list. Students are trained on the types of missions performed by rotary wing aircraft, aircraft safety, aero-medical evacuation procedures, pathfinder operations, principle and techniques of combat assaults, repelling techniques and sling load operations.

It is the unit's responsibility to ensure a student has met all administrative and medical requirements for AAC. Failing to meet all entry requirements for AAC, will result in the student not being able to in-process.

The following is a consolidated guideline for entry requirements:

- **Must have 5 copies of TDY orders with authorized fund cite (DD form 1610) bringing student to the WTC AAC. If using DTS— ensure the orders are printed in the official **DD FM 1610 format**. Personnel are **NOT** authorized to attend on permissive TDY or Leave status. Must say WTC Air Assault attendance in Block 16 (Remarks section) of the DD FM 1610.**
- **Must coordinate with AF LNO regardless of having an ATRRS reservation.**
- **Must have DD 2807-1 & DD 2808 or PHA completed within 1 year.**

- Must have Immunization printout.
- Completed WTC Form 100 signed by Commander:
- Must have completed US Army Physical Fitness Test within 30 days of class start date in the 17-21 year old age group with a minimum score of 60%. The AFPT will be documented on form DA 705.

REPORTING INSTRUCTIONS:

All Air Force students will report in Air Force PT uniform on Monday with ID tags, ID card and a 1 quart canteen along with all administrative paperwork and packing list. It is mandatory for AF personnel to coordinate with the AF Liaison for specific link-up times prior to in-processing with the WTC. In-processing is at 0900 on MONDAY at the ARNG Warrior Training Center, 6901 Russell Road, Bldg. 4159 (Bravo Company).
