



Military Spouse Hiring Authority Executive Order 13473

2010 Federal Employees Week



E.O. 13473



- Effective September 11, 2009
- Authorizes appointments in the civil service for.....
 - (1) spouses of military members on active duty (other than training) that relocate or PCS with the military member;
 - (2) spouses of retired or separated active duty members who have a 100% service connected disability; and
 - (3) an un-married widow/widower of a service member who died while performing active duty.



Eligibility for Priority Placement Program

- Spouses who relocated or PCS with military member on or after September 11, 2009.
- Must be well qualified
- Program S



Eligibility



Spouse relocated or PCS'd with military member within the last two years prior to September 11, 2009.

Eligible to apply to vacancy announcements that indicate Executive Order 13473 in the area of consideration.



Eligibility Timeframe



2 years from:

- (1) PCS orders;
- (2) Documentation verifying the member is 100 percent disabled; or
- (3) Documentation verifying the member was killed while on active duty.



Additional Information

Does not constitute a hiring preference, nor does it create an entitlement to a Federal job.

Military spouses must meet OPM Qualifications Standards for individual positions.
