COMMUNITY NOTICE: Wildfires continue on Benning

FORT BENNING, Ga. – Several wildfires continue to burn on the installation in the Malone Complex, Kilo and Alpha areas to include A-20 impact area.

The wildfires are contained to their specific areas but will continue to burn and smolder for several days.

Forecasted east winds will send the smoke west tonight and tomorrow.

The cooler temperatures tonight will allow the smoke to settle in low lying areas, especially along creeks and streams. All cantonment areas to include the Martin Army Community Hospital and in South Columbus will likely be affected by the smoke in the morning.
