2. THIS MESSAGE IS TO INFORM ALL ACTIVE DUTY SERVICE MEMBERS ABOUT UPDATES TO THE APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS FOR ATTENDING THE RANGER ASSESSMENT AND SELECTION PROGRAM (RASP) 1 AND 2. FOR SERVICE MEMBERS SEEKING ASSIGNMENT TO THE 75TH RANGER REGIMENT.

3. ALL ACTIVE DUTY SERVICE MEMBERS IN THE GRADE OF E1 TO E8, WO1 TO WO4 AND O1 TO O4 ARE NOW ELIGIBLE TO APPLY TO BE ASSESSED FOR ASSIGNMENT TO THE 75TH RANGER REGIMENT. A LIST OF MOS / BRANCH / CAREER FIELDS REQUIRED IN THE 75TH RANGER REGIMENT IS BELOW:

4. REQUIREMENTS TO SUBMIT AN APPLICATION ARE LISTED BELOW. WAIVERS WILL BE CONSIDERED ON A LIMITED, CASE BY CASE BASIS:

A. BE A U.S. CITIZEN.

B. BE ON ACTIVE DUTY AND VOLUNTEER FOR ASSIGNMENT.

C. HAVE A GT SCORE OF 105 OR HIGHER (ENLISTED); BE A GRADUATE OF BRANCH SPECIFIC BASIC OFFICER LEADER COURSE (WARRANT AND COMMISSIONED OFFICER).

D. BE CAPABLE OF PASSING INITIAL ENTRY PHYSICAL REQUIREMENTS WHICH INCLUDE THE RANGER FITNESS TEST (58 PUSH UPS, 69 SIT UPS, RUN 5 MILES IN 40 MINUTES OR LESS, 6 CHIN UPS); COMPLETE A WATER SURVIVAL ASSESSMENT TEST AND CONDUCT A 12 MILE FOOTMARCH WITH A 35LB RUCKSACK AND WEAPON IN UNDER 3 HOURS.

E. MUST BE AIRBORNE QUALIFIED OR VOLUNTEER TO ATTEND AIRBORNE TRAINING.

F. NO PENDING UCMJ ACTION OR DRUG/ALCOHOL RELATED INCIDENTS WITHIN THE LAST 24 MONTHS.

G. ENLISTED SOLDIERS MUST BE ELIGIBLE FOR A SECRET CLEARANCE WITH POSSIBLE TOP SECRET CLEARANCE. OFFICERS MUST BE ELIGIBLE FOR POSSIBLE TOP SECRET CLEARANCE.

H. FEMALE SOLDIERS MUST HAVE A NEGATIVE PREGNANCY TEST WITHIN 30 DAYS PRIOR TO THEIR RASP REPORT DATE.

5. INTERESTED CANDIDATES SHOULD SUBMIT APPLICATIONS OR QUESTIONS TO [75OFFICERRECRUIT@SOC.MIL](mailto:75OFFICERRECRUIT@SOC.MIL) (WO1 TO WO4; O1 TO O4) OR [75RECRUIT@SOC.MIL](mailto:75RECRUIT@SOC.MIL) (E1 TO E8). INITIAL INQUIRIES SHOULD BE SUBMITTED BY EMAIL AND INCLUDE THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:

A. EMAIL SUBJECT LINE: "LAST NAME, FIRST NAME, RANK, BRANCH/MOS, YEAR GROUP\*" (\*OFFICERS ONLY).

B. ATTACHMENTS: ORB / ERB; ALL OERS / NCOERS. FILES MUST BE IN .PDF FORMAT AND COMPILED AS A SINGLE DOCUMENT. ATTACHMENT CANNOT EXCEED 6MB OR IT WILL NOT BE DELIVERED.

C. BODY OF THE EMAIL: CURRENT DUTY POSITION AND TIME IN THAT POSITION; MONTH AND YEAR YOUR CHAIN OF COMMAND SUPPORTS ALLOWING YOU TO ATTEND RASP; UNIQUE QUALIFICATIONS THAT DISTINGUISH YOU FROM YOUR PEERS.

D. CANDIDATES WHO PASS THE INITIAL SCREENING WILL RECEIVE SPECIFIC INSTRUCTIONS ON SUBMITTING ADDITIONAL DOCUMENTS WHICH MAY INCLUDE: A ONE PAGE LETTER OF INTENT ADDRESSED TO THE REGIMENTAL COMMANDER, LETTERS OF RECOMMENDATION FROM CURRENT RATER AND SENIOR RATER, DA FORM 705 (APFT SCORECARD) WITHIN LAST 6

MONTHS, LEADER VALIDATION MEMO (FORMAT TO BE PROVIDED), PRE-SCREENING QUESTIONNAIRE (FORMAT TO BE PROVIDED), DA 4187 FOR REASSIGNMENT (FORMAT TO BE PROVIDED).

6. CANDIDATE APPLICATIONS WILL BE SCREENED AND REVIEWED BY LEADERS WITHIN THE 75TH RANGER REGIMENT. THE SCREENING AND APPROVAL PROCESS CAN TAKE AS LONG AS 8 TO 12 WEEKS BEFORE A FINAL DECISION HAS BEEN REACHED. ACCEPTED CANDIDATES WILL RECEIVE DIRECT CORRESPONDENCE REGARDING ASSESSMENT DATES AND TIMING.

7. APPROVED APPLICANTS WILL BE INVITED TO ATTEND THE RANGER ASSESSMENT AND SELECTION PROGRAM (RASP) AT FORT BENNING, GEORGIA. RASP 1 IS FOR ENLISTED SERVICE MEMBERS IN THE GRADE OF E1 TO E5 AND IS APPROXIMATELY 8 WEEKS LONG. RASP 2 IS FOR SERVICE MEMBERS IN THE GRADE OF E6 TO O4 AND IS APPROXIMATELY 3 WEEKS LONG. UPON SUCCESSFUL COMPLETION OF RASP, CANDIDATES WILL BE ASSIGNED TO THE 75TH RANGER REGIMENT.
